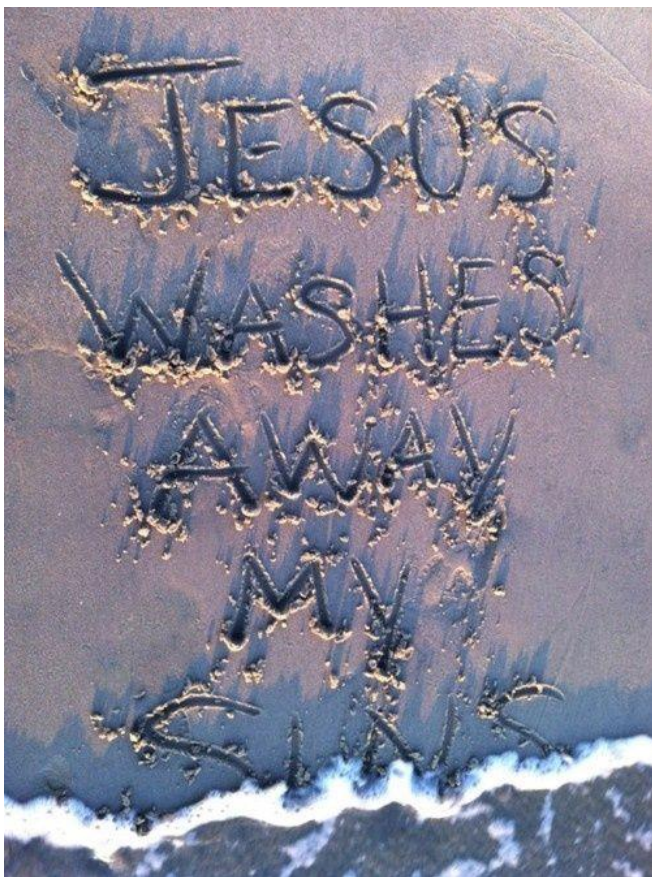
The draw will be held on Sunday, June 19th in during Fellowship Hour.
