

Motherhood: A Joyful Blessing in Afghanistan

In Canada, the news of pregnancy often brings joy and hope to expecting mothers.

But for many women in Afghanistan, becoming a mother can be risky because it is difficult to access the necessary medical care to support pregnant women.

Guldasta felt fear when she learned she was pregnant. "I was pregnant three times," she shares. "Each time, I lost the baby in my first or second trimester"

A female health committee member encouraged Guldasta to visit a Presbyterian World Service & Development supported clinic. At the clinic, she learned about the causes of her miscarriages. With proper treatment and the care of a midwife, Guldasta's health and well-being improved. Eventually, she delivered a healthy baby in the clinic.

Support for PWS&D maternal health programs has allowed for the

training of female health workers and the construction of delivery rooms in Afghanistan.
